

List of Approved Upper Division Electives (updated: Winter 2024)

Note: Effective Summer 2022, the department will be issuing a moratorium on upper division elective petitions. What this means is that if a course has not been successfully petitioned before, that course cannot be petitioned to count as an elective while the moratorium is in place. The 6 upper division electives have to come from the list below. Please note that *at least* 2 of the 6 upper division electives need to be in the subject area of Soc Gen.

Courses in **red** do not automatically show on DARS. If you have already completed one of these courses in red with a letter grade of C- or better, please fill out the <u>Upper Division Elective Request Form</u> on our website under the Petitions page. These requests will be processed every Friday at 4 PM (or Thursday of that week if the Friday is a holiday). If you submit after this cutoff, please wait until the following Friday to have the changes reflected on your DARS.

Please note that for electives offered outside of ISG, you would need to honor the prerequisites and enrollment rules imposed by the department offering those electives. Lastly, please also note that 4-5 units = 1 elective, and 2 units = ½ of an elective.
